### We're Closing In

All of our exterior CMU block walls on the project have been completed, and now our focus has shifted to becoming weather tight. Our waterproofing and air and vapor barrier crews have started to coat the outer shell of CMU block. Meanwhile, the Ironworkers have been prepping the gymnasium trusses for receiving its ceiling liner that will hold up the roof insulation. Inside, the floorplan has really started to take shape. Carpenters have framed up the interior classrooms, bathrooms, and administrative offices. Plumbing, HVAC, & Electrical trades have started their interior rough-ins in the classrooms. Our Roofing contractor has mobilized and delivered a bunch of their materials that will be installed over the classrooms. Down at the ball diamonds, concrete has been poured for the dugout slabs. Top Notch has begun framing up the four dugouts. Also, new concrete pads have been poured for where the bleachers will be stationed. The outfield fence has been installed, and sod is almost complete in the outfield.
